2. Evaluation

- a. **Documentation Evaluation:** Evaluation is based on undergraduate academic records, graduate academic records (for doctoral applicants only), study and research plan, and letters of recommendation. (Additional evaluation criteria may be applied by each department.)
- b. **Interview:** An interview may be conducted by each department if deemed necessary (either in-person or online).

3. Eligibility and Quota

a. Eligibility

(1) Master's Program and Integrated Master's–Doctoral Program

- ① The applicant and both parents must be foreign nationals.
- ② Applicants must have obtained (or be expected to obtain) a bachelor's degree from a domestic or overseas university.
- ③ Applicants recognized as having an equivalent or higher level of education in accordance with relevant laws and regulations are also eligible.

(2) Doctoral Program

- ① The applicant and both parents must be foreign nationals.
- ② Applicants must have obtained (or be expected to obtain) a master's degree from a domestic or overseas university.
- ③ Applicants recognized as having an equivalent or higher level of education in accordance with relevant laws and regulations are also eligible.

b. Quota: There is no fixed limit on the number of applicants.

4. Language Proficiency Criteria and Field of Admission

- a. Please **check** the Language Proficiency Criteria for each department in advance before submitting applications, and **submit one of the mandatory language transcripts**.
- b. **TOPIK(Test of Proficiency in Korean) is mandatory(LV3 or above)**. The score is required for **all** international students. Certified English Transcripts may be accepted, but varies with departments.
- c. In case of applicant's Language Proficiency Criteria does not meet the requirements, applicant can be exempted from Language Proficiency Criteria by written document, "Admission Recommendation"

<Admission Recommendation>

▶ It should be filled and signed by both **KAU Professor and Head Professor** from each department.

▶ Enrolled students who submitted "Admission Recommendation" **MUST meet Language Proficiency Criteria for each department by submitting its transcripts before the evaluation of thesis**

▶ In case of Service Management major, four semesters (one year) of Korean Class by KAU KLEC are required for one year after entering the school(Only if the applicants don't have TOPIK LV3 or more)

▶ **In case of Global Service Management who do not submit a TOPIK LV 3 or above must complete both the 200-hour online Korean language course and the 75-hour Korean language course at KAU before admission. If not completed prior to enrollment, these courses must be completed after admission.**

8. Issuance of Admission Certificate

a. Students who have received the admission notice will proceed with the issuance of the standard Certificate of Admission using the following documents:

- (1) Passport and Alien Registration Card
- (2) Bank statement showing a balance of at least USD 20,000, RMB 13,000, or KRW 23,000,000 in the name of the applicant, a parent, or a financial guarantor (the balance must be maintained until enrollment)
- (3) Original certificate of the highest degree obtained and transcript; for graduates from Chinese universities, the original verification certificate of degree
- (4) Notarized English copy of the household register listing all family members, or notarized certificate of family relations
- (5) Proof of tuition payment, etc.

※ **The required documents may vary depending on individual circumstances.**

[Guide Regarding Apostille and Consular Authentication]

1. Submission Guide for Educational Background Verification Documents from Overseas Schools

Applicants must obtain one of the following verifications (A to C) for their graduation and academic transcript (enrollment) certificates issued abroad and submit them during the document submission period.

(However, documents issued by Korean schools abroad authorized by the Ministry of Education do not require consular authentication.)

- A. Academic documents (graduation and transcript) verified by Apostille.
- B. Academic documents (graduation and transcript) verified by the Korean Consulate in the host country.
A 'Confirmation of Overseas Educational Institution' can be submitted instead of consular authentication.
- C. Academic and Degree Verification Reports issued by the China Higher Education Student Information and Career Center (www.chsi.com.cn). Only for those who obtained their academic background within China.

2. Information Regarding the Apostille Convention

A. Apostille Convention

- 1) Convention Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents (Effective in South Korea since July 14, 2007)
- 2) It abolishes the consular authentication process for public documents between member countries for smoother mutual authentication; instead, the issuing country confirms the document's validity.
- 3) Documents verified by an Apostille from a member country have the same legal effect as consular authentication from an overseas diplomatic mission.
- 4) When applying for a visa issuance certificate, documents requiring consular authentication are also recognized if they have undergone existing consular authentication (for non-member countries) or Apostille verification.

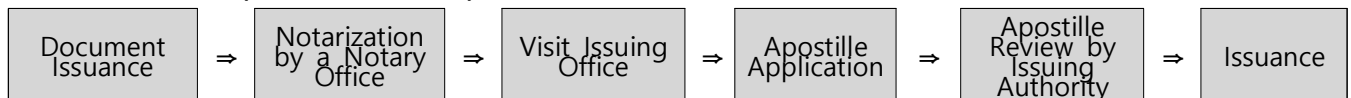

9. Other Remarks

- a. To help students pursue and achieve their academic and professional aspirations, **all applicants must consult with the head of department on assignment of an academic advisor before application.**
- b. Application can be made by online, and all the required documents must be submitted or candidate can be rejected.
- c. Any modification cannot be made after application, and admission fee cannot be refunded after the period of application
- d. The acceptance will be revoked if candidate's documents are found to be false or counterfeit, and revealed to be admitted improperly
- e. All required documents must be original(Except for passport or residence card).
If copies are submitted due to certain conditions, applicant must submit original document before Enrollment.
- f. The documents written in foreign languages, except Korean or English, must be submitted along with publicly notarized copies translated in Korean or English.
- g. Admission results will be notified individually.
- h. if applicant does not make a tuition payment within the period of registration, one's acceptance will be nullified
- i. if applicant name does not match with submitted documents, a proof of identical person issued by applicant nation's court should be submitted.
- j. if applicant is an expected graduate candidate at the point of application, applicant must submit a diploma after graduation
- k. it is applicants' full responsibility to read the admission guide, and graduate school does not take any responsibility from not acknowledging any information.
- l. Unwritten information regarding admission complies with the Committed of Graduate School
- m. All students should comply with all the Graduate School Laws and Regulations after enrollment.
